

PROGRAM REVIEW

Rule 11. Ice Hockey

Section 1: Article 1: The game shall consist of three(3) periods of 15 minutes.

NEW: An exception may be allowed when participating out of state.

Rationale for addition:

By state adoption National Federation rules permit schools to play up to 17 minute periods. This exception will permit member schools to be in compliance with NJSIAA and NFHS rules when competing against out of state teams.

Rule 11. Ice Hockey

Section 1: Article 3: There shall be no overtime periods, except in playoffs ,regular season tournaments, or when playing out of state.

Rationale for addition :

NJSIAA schools playing in regular season tournaments that require teams to advance need a method to determine a winner.

CL: Overtime will only be permitted during the regular season when playing out of state for purposes of complying with host state rules.

SOCCKER

Rule 14, Section 8 (new) – A soccer player shall play in no more than three (3) halves during the same calendar day, with a maximum of nine halves per week. If a school elects to play a four game week (Rule 14, Section 6), an individual player may not exceed twelve (12) halves. This would include any combination of: freshman, sophomore, junior varsity and varsity competition. NOTE: overtime periods are a continuation of the second half.
