- A school's coaches and teams or individuals must report to the scoreboard table at least one-half (1/2) hour prior to their tee-off time.
- Golfers, accompanied by their coach, will be permitted to play the course prior to May 24. A special reduced practice round fee will be charged. Contact Al Conover or Jorge Diaz at (908)369-8200.
- No spectators are permitted on the course.

ATTENTION GOLFERS:

1. NO CADDIES, NO ELECTRIC CARTS, NO PULL CARTS, NO CELL PHONES, NO SMOKING (automatic disqualification). Foursome supervisors will be provided with carts.
2. Members and guests of Neshanic Valley Golf Course are not allowed to bring in food or drink from the outside. However, since there is limited water on the course, it is suggested that teams bring water.
3. Dress code will be strictly enforced. Golfers in violation may be subject to disqualification. NO JEANS or T-SHIRTS. Players and coaches must wear pants or shorts and collared golf shirts (No Denim). Neshanic Valley Golf Course prohibits the use of traditional metal or ceramic spikes. Golfers must come dressed to play.
4. Driving range will be open. Putting green will be open. Balls will be provided by Neshanic Valley Golf Course.
5. Restrooms available on the course. Lunch will be provided courtesy of the Metropolitan Golf Association Foundation and the New Jersey State Golf Association, at the Club House area prior to the tee-off time at 1:00 p.m.
6. No team or individual will be allowed to compete unless the coach or certified faculty member is present; coaches are responsible for the conduct of their players – rake traps, replaced divots, repair ball marks. Coaches must ensure golfers replace divots and repair ball marks on greens.
7. COACHES ARE NOT TO PLAY. LEAVE YOUR CLUBS AT HOME. Coaches will be needed to supervise a foursome or in some other capacity. The coach

- accompanying a foursome will act as fore caddy to spot golf balls, speed up play and be official scorer for the foursome. (Please double check each player's score on the next tee and again at the end of the 9<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> holes before reporting same at scoreboard.) Each player should also keep score (unofficial).
8. Summer Rules – All putts must be holed unless notified otherwise due to weather or course conditions. Tournament Director has the option to play Winter Rules if conditions necessitate same.
  9. Question or Rulings – Official ruling will be made by NJSGA before final recording of official score.
  10. Assistant coaches, if available, should report to the Tournament Director to assist in supervision of foursome – please bring an assistant coach if you are permitted by your school.
  11. Cell phone and electronic devices (IPODs, Palm Pilots, Range Finders, etc.) are not permitted on the course.

*Directions to Neshanic Valley Golf Course*

- Route 202 South and make left onto Chubb Way (Route 646) OR
- Route 202 North and make right onto Chubb Way (Route 646). Chubb Way will merge with South Branch Road (Route 567). Neshanic Valley Golf Course is three miles on the left.
