The NJSIAA Awards Committee will accept nominations for the following awards up to October 1, 2014:

- (1) Award of Honor  
Nominee must have exerted a positive, wide-reaching influence on the total athletic programs of the State Association for a sustained period.  
  
Nominee must have demonstrated outstanding leadership through a league/conference, or NJSIAA service.  
  
National recognition through the nominee's efforts should be noted.
- (2) Sports Award  
Nominee must have made an outstanding contribution to interscholastic athletics, e.g., career record; league/conference, NJSIAA championship at the varsity level. Award only given to those individuals who have made a credible impact upon the sport.
- (3) Service Award  
Nominee must have made an outstanding contribution to NJSIAA/High School Athletics in New Jersey. All categories other than coaches, officials, sportswriters.
- (4) Officiating Award  
Nominee must have made an outstanding contribution as a varsity official; e.g., career service and championship game(s) officiated.
- (5) Sportswriters Award  
Nominee must have made an outstanding contribution to interscholastic athletics in the area of journalism.

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**General Criteria  
All Awards**

Applications must be submitted by October 1, 2014 on appropriate enclosed forms.

A member school may nominate only one candidate for any of the award categories, i.e., for a sport award the school may not nominate anyone in any other category.

An outstanding coaching record, while important, does not in itself merit consideration for an Award of Honor nomination.

Local awards, or "Coach of the Year" awards more properly contribute towards an award in a particular sport rather than the Award of Honor.

The Selection Committee may select one recipient statewide in each category.

The nominee will remain on active file for two years. The year of nomination and the year following.

All applications other than the Award of Honor require a letter of recommendation from the principal of a member school and the submitting party if applicable.

Award of Honor nominees require the endorsement of a present Executive Committee member as well as the signature of the Principal of a member school.
