

## History of NJSIAA Boys Bowling Championships

(From the 1958 NJSIAA Record Book): "Bowling was added to the program of the NJSIAA for the first time this year. 42 schools entered teams with 210 boys taking part. Long Branch High School winning the team championship with a total of 2,657 pins to nip Bloomfield High School by 20 pins. High individual honors went to Jeff Shein of New Brunswick High School scoring 617 pins for a three-game series."
