### **INSTRUCTIONS FOR BAND DIRECTORS**

All bands must be preapproved by the NJSIAA office. Bands are only permitted to play at Rutgers University. Pre-determined high school sites for Sectional and/or State Semi-Finals are not necessarily neutral sites. Therefore, no bands will be permitted at this level of play. Please email Al Stumpf ([astumpf@njsiaa.org](mailto:astumpf@njsiaa.org)) if you plan to bring your band.

Band performance should be guided by the following:

1. DO NOT play during the game.
2. DO NOT utilize any of the instruments AT ANY TIME during the game.
3. DO NOT play while the cheerleaders are performing on the court.
4. Coordinate with the other band directors, if applicable, as to rotation of performance times.
5. At the conclusion of your game, if there is another band from the school for the game to follow, you are to vacate the area and allow them your space.

**RE: GUIDELINES FOR CHEERLEADERS**

1. All National Federation Spirit Rules must be followed, including Sportsmanship Guidelines. Please specifically note rules for pyramids, partner stunts and tumbling.
2. Squads are limited to twenty-five (25) uniformed varsity cheerleaders, plus one (1) team mascot. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
3. Cheerleaders should make a positive contribution at an athletic contest to create better relations between opposing team supporters.
4. Cheers should be positive, not aimed at antagonizing the opponent or the opposing cheerleaders. Care should be taken in making certain that words used in a cheer are not suggestive and do not have a connotation which would inflame an audience.
5. Cheerleaders should remain silent when the opponents' cheerleaders are cheering and during attempted free throws.
6. Cheerleaders are expected to lead the cheer group in a round of applause for an injured player leaving the game. Cheering is appropriate.
7. When "booing" occurs, cheerleaders should help to divert the crowd's attention by starting a popular yell routine. Immediate action is the key to the control of booing.
8. Cheerleaders, properly trained, can be as important to the spectator behavior as the coach is to his/her team.
9. Cheerleader Advisor **MUST NOTIFY HOME SITE IF TAPE RECORDER** will be used during halftime.
10. **Basketball Rules Committee added Rule 1-20 regarding non-playing personnel – such as cheerleaders – on the court during a short time-out. The rule states that “non-playing personnel shall remain outside of the playing area during a 30-second or less time-out during the game. Non-playing personnel shall stand outside the free-throw lane lines extended toward the sidelines throughout the game.**
