- Purpose of new post season meeting set up- Committee members- explained
- 2. Review of the regular season (Positive / Negative)
 - Double Par- return to regulations was deleted in this year's re-write.
 - Competitor keeping their own scores and scores of others in group.- Coaches need to emphasize next year.
 - Later cut -off date- depends on the calendar
 - Playing lost ball from fairway 2 stroke penalty instead of stroke and distancereturn this to the regulations
 - Girls playing 1 tee up- no change keep as is. Group felt with many course adding tees, the difference was not that great.
- 3. Review of the post-season (Positive / Negative)
 - Review of sectional Directors and Courses- All courses were reviewed. Some coaches wanted to change the NP South Site- group felt it was not a good idea to leave sites we have a good long term relationship with. Letters have been sent out for next year.

Girls Championship – Raritan Valley would like to host again in 2023- they enjoyed having the girls there.

- Reducing number of Independent Participants qualifying from Sectionals to 3 from each Sectional. **Committee was not in favor of this.**
- Deciding what types of distance measuring devices are legal. GPS Watches in particular.- Wording to define what is allowed will be added to the regulations. Cannot be a device that allows communication with others.
- Sectional Tie breaker- use score of 5th player.- Committee endorses using the 5th players score. If still tied use USGA Tiebreaker will be spelled out in the Regulations.
- Alternating Central/South Sectional sites each year.- Committee did not change felt we need to keep the courses we have locked up.
- Girl's golf- separate public and NP team tournaments.- See # 6
- 4. Review of dates for next season (See Handout)
 - Review of proposed dates 2022-23 season- Practice start date is confirmed as March 16 Matches can begin March 23.
- 5. Review of current regulations and any proposed changes for next season.
 - Document will be reviewed at meeting.- This will be done during the summer.

 - New seeding system for boy's golf qualification for post season
 - Expansion of sections for girl's golf and its impact on the post season.
