

2024-25 NJSIAA Boys & Girls Individual Swimming Tournament

NJSIAA reserves the right to adjust, change or cancel dates, times, and locations for all NJSIAA State tournaments. Member schools will not be eligible to participate in any NJSIAA Tournaments if it has violated the NJSIAA Constitution, Bylaws, Rules, Regulations, Guidelines, Policies, or Procedures. Any student-athlete who transfers after the competition start date will not be eligible for this tournament (Bylaws, Article V, Section 4.K. 5).

Schools entering the tournament will not be granted a change of date/time due to any conflicts with school trips, proms, banquets, SATs, unless agreed upon by both schools. The NJSIAA will make every effort to accommodate schools that have a conflict with their graduation.

Schools that are disqualified from state tournament competition after the tournament has been seeded but prior to the bracket being final, then the bracket will be reseeded and the next ranked school who entered the tournament will be included. If a school is disqualified from state tournament competition after the tournament has been seeded and after the bracket is final, then the bracket will not be reseeded, and no additional school will be included. If a school is disqualified from state tournament competition during the state tournament, then the school will be removed from the tournament immediately and their last opponent will advance in their place.

Schools participating in any NJSIAA tournament are responsible for the actions and behaviors of their spectators. Schools are required to provide adequate staff security to ensure there is proper oversight of their spectators. In addition, schools are financially responsible for any damages to the property or premises caused by their student-athletes, staff, or spectators (spectators include, but are not limited to, cheerleaders, marching band participants, students, and other fans).

NJSIAA requires Certified Athletic Trainers at all its tournament events. The ATC must document all injuries on an injury report form. This form must be available to the NJSIAA upon request.

Member schools not willing or able to comply with these tournament regulations and any relevant procedures found in the Operating Procedures Handbook should not enter the tournament. Member schools are encouraged to review these tournament regulations with the school administration. Coaches must have a copy of these regulations as well as a copy of the Rule Modifications (if any) for this tournament available at all contests. Copies of these documents are available on the NJSIAA website.

- 1. The Non-Public A & B classifications will be combined to form a non-public north & non-public south.
- 2. The non-publics will have sectional championships.
- 3. We will continue to use the top 3 PowerPointed meets for PowerPoint calculations.
- 4. The qualifying and improving of seed times will now include the state final times on 2/5/24.
- 5. Only the swimmers that qualify for the finals at the MOC prelims will come back the next day.
- 6. There will only be ONE heat for each event at the individual MOC finals.
- 7. The MOC finals will swim boys and girls together.

To Qualify for the Individual Tournament

- 1. A student attending a member school that competes in swimming on an interscholastic basis must swim as a member of their high school team in at least 50% of the school's total dual contests while they are eligible. If there is an odd number remaining, then the swimmer must compete in the greater number.
- 2. Swimmers returning from medical leave or ineligible swimmers becoming eligible must compete in 50% of the remaining contests when they become eligible. If there is an odd number remaining, then the swimmer must compete in the greater number.
- 3. Individual swimmers must have attained the qualifying time for each event they are entering by the dates listed. Qualifying times must have been attained between Opening Day and the Individual Cutoff date listed.
- 4. All times entered must be verifiable. The contest committee reserves the right to disqualify swimmers from an event if the time cannot be verified. All Coaches should be prepared to provide such verification at the contest.
- 5. Girls who swim on member schools sponsoring only boys or co-ed swimming programs, and want to qualify for a relay, are required to swim as a relay team composed of four girls when attaining the qualifying time.
- 6. All swimmers must strictly follow all deadline dates listed above.

Independent Swimmers

An independent swimmer who is enrolled in a NJSIAA member school that does not sponsor an interscholastic swimming program may enter, provided the school follows all entry requirements below.

Independent Swimmer Qualifications

- 1. Individuals from member schools that do not compete on an interscholastic basis are eligible to qualify as independent swimmers, provided they have met the qualifying times between opening day and the Hy-Tek Individual entries close date listed above.
- 2. All times entered must be verifiable. The contest committee reserves the right to disqualify swimmers from an event if the time cannot be verified. All Coaches should be prepared to provide such verification at the contest
- 3. All qualifying times must be in yards under USA or YMCA rules and submitted in yards.
- Member schools entering independent swimmers must provide a coach/chaperone to accompany the swimmer.

- 5. The coach/chaperone must be approved by the school district's board of education, headmaster, etc.
- 6. The school district must be able to certify the independent swimmer/s has met the required six (6) practices.
- 7. Independent swimmers will not be able to check-in to the event with a parent, a coach/chaperone must be present at time of check-in.
- 8. The penalty for failure to comply will be the disqualification of the individual(s).
- 9. A properly appointed coach/chaperone will thereafter be subject to the rules and regulations regarding "Out-Of-Season Practices".

Entry Procedure

- 1. All schools must use Hy-Tek for entering individuals into events.
- 2. All Hy-Tex entries must be submitted via email to the entry coordinator and tournament director listed below.
- 3. Either Hy-Tek Team Manager or TM II Lite may be used. TM II Lite may be downloaded without charge from the following site: www.besmarttinc.com. Directions for use are also available on this site.
- 4. From the Team Manager, send the "individual contest entry report, by the name" and the "relay entry report". These reports can be Word documents!
- 5. E-mail entry should include the zip file from the Team Manager of your entries, as well as a recap of the number of individual entries and relay entries.
- 6. All Hy-Tek entries must be emailed to the entry coordinator by the date listed.
- 7. Please adhere to all due dates, we will not accept any entries after the dates listed.
- 8. Only updated seed times and wildcard entries will be accepted after the Individual entry deadline date.
- 9. The last date for wildcard entries and updating of seed times is up to and including the state semi-finals.
- 10. All USA Swimmers, please input your 14-character hexadecimal US Swimmer ID with your entry if you want the MOC results sent to the SWIMS database. We will no longer sign-up US Swimmers at the MOC.

Updating Seed times

All individual swimmers from member schools that have qualified for the tournament and have submitted an entry by the deadline, may update their seedtime up to and including the state semi-final contests. All individual swimmers that have achieved a faster seed time must email the Entry Coordinator by 12:00pm the next day to: besmarttinc@gmail.com

<u>Wildcard Qualifiers</u>: Swimmers from member schools that did not qualify by the Individual Cutoff date, but their team is still competing in the state tournament can qualify during the team tournament. The online individual entry form must be completed and a Hy-Tek entry must be emailed to the Entry Coordinator by 12:00pm the next day following the contest which the time was achieved to: besmarttinc@gmail.com. The last date for wildcard entries is up to and including the state semi-finals.

Carefully check the times of your entrants. Do not enter a swimmer whose time is not equal to or better than those listed above. This is a championship contest, and you must adhere to the cut-off times. Coaches should be prepared to certify the times of any entrant on the day of the contest. The contest committee reserves the right to disqualify the school or swimmer when times cannot be certified for this event. This could also result in disqualification in the subsequent year. Additionally, a fine may be imposed on the coach or school.

Entry Fee

- \$16.00 for each individual event and \$25.00 for each relay.
- Payable to the NJSIAA (Please note Swimming Tournament).

Tournament Rules & Information

- 1. The NFHS Swimming Rules along with any NJSIAA swimming rule modifications will govern this tournament.
- 2. A competitor shall be permitted to enter a maximum of four (4) events, no more than two (2) of which may be individual events.
- 3. Each team shall be permitted a maximum of four (4) entries in an individual event and one (1) team in a relay event.
- 4. Relay teams can submit up to four (4) alternates with your relay entries. Teams will not be permitted to substitute swimmers in a relay if they do not appear on the entry form.
- 5. All Scratches for the finals must be made within 30 minutes of event results being announced.
- 6. Coaches will be able to check in 30min before warm-up time. Coaches will need to be checked in no later than 15min before the start of the contest. No athlete will be permitted in the water until a coach or school-approved personnel are on site.
- 7. There will be no limit to the wristbands for the coaches as long as they are approved by the school and listed on the entry form. They must be coaches that have coached all year, you cannot add coaches for the state tournament unless approved by the contest director or the NJSIAA.
- 8. All coaches must check in with proper ID to receive their wristband. Coaches will no longer be permitted to pick up other coaches' wristbands.
- 9. Shaving in the locker room/shower area will not be permitted at the Gloucester County Institute of Technology
- 10. Lockers will be provided. Please bring a lock. Responsibility for personal belongings rests with the individual.
- 11. The NJSIAA, GLOUCESTER INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY, shall in no way be liable for damages of any kind sustained in any manner in connection with the conduct of the Championships.
- 12. Only competitors who qualify and the school's personnel will be admitted at the competitors' entrance.
- 13. Exhibition events/swimmers are not permitted.

- 14. Glass containers are prohibited in the pool/locker room areas.
- 15. No changing permitted on deck.
- 16. State Individual records can be set with proper verification by Contest Referee, Head Judge, and Head Timer
- 17. Individual championships will begin on time. No event will be held up for any swimmer for any reason. All events will have consolation and final heats.
- 18. Participation by an ineligible swimmer will result in forfeiture of all times and places achieved by the ineligible swimmer and the next finisher will advance in his/her place. Swimmers eliminated before the last event will not re-enter the championship competition.
- 19. All coaches/certified faculty members must be properly certified and appointed by the Board of Education/Heads of Schools. Tournament Directors will disqualify any contestant who is accompanied by someone in a coaching/supervisory capacity who is not appointed by the school district.
- 20. Coaches' wristbands will be issued, which will allow access to the deck area, for all coaches listed on the entry form. Children and guests of coaches will not be permitted on the deck area. Only female swimmers are permitted when the Girls Swim is being conducted and only male swimmers are permitted when the Boys Swim is being conducted.
- 21. Mechanical noisemakers and balloons are not permitted in the pool area as well.
- 22. No face paint is permitted on the pool deck.
- 23. Because of the indoor conditions, bands will not be admitted into the site.
- 24. Please inform swimmers that no food is allowed in the immediate pool area. You will be held responsible for their conduct. Please ask everyone to help keep the pool area, locker room area, and campus clean.

Championship Costs for Schools & Officials

- 1. The NJSIAA will incur all costs regarding the Meet of Champions.
- 2. The NJSIAA will assign and pay for all officials.

Awards

- 1. The top eight (8) swimmers competing in the Individual State Championship Finals will be awarded medals.
- 2. Awards will be presented following each event. Participation by the top 8 is mandatory. Coaches' cooperation is essential.
- 3. For the awards ceremony, competitors must wear school apparel or apparel without logos.

NFHS Swimsuit Rules

This tournament will be conducted under NFHS rules and therefore will follow all NFHS swimsuit rules.

Swimsuit Transgender Clarification:

- Pursuant to NJ law and NJSIAA policy is that the student decides what swimsuit is appropriate. We permit the student to make the decision.
- NFHS Swim Rules-boys swim, we permit the Transgender Male to wear a men's suit, a women's suit, or a men's suit with covering (sports bra, etc.)
- Full bodysuits are not permitted.
- Long or short sleeve "rash guard" shirt is permitted.
- Transgender females may wear either.

Swimsuit Religious Clarification:

Swimmers are permitted to wear "compression shirts/Rash Guard" type apparel <u>under</u> their school uniform because of religious reasons, as long as the apparel is not designed to enhance the performance of the swimmer. Full-body suits are not permitted.
