

At Glen Ridge, was the 1st girls basketball coach to win a conference championship (5 total Colonial Hills Conference Championships). Her teams competed in the NJSIAA tournament for 19 consecutive years and were ranked yearly in Essex County's top 10. Coached all 3 of the 1,000 point scorers in Glen Ridge HS girls basketball history.
Named Field Hockey Coach of the Year 2 out of the 3 years served as head coach. Also named Soccer COY 2 times, and Basketball COY 5 times.
Inducted into both the Paramus Catholic Athletic

Hall of Fame and the Glen Ridge HS Athletic HOF.


